
Some things are central to who we are. We continue to offer choices in where and how you give, while raising important funds for our nonprofit partners.


We also look at new ways to raise awareness of CSF and our members, to reach more people, and increase the impact of Community Services Fund and our nonprofit members.

CSF is a simple and effective way to match donors with nonprofits to support a wide range of diverse programs and services that improve the lives of all Nebraskans throughout the state.


Donors choose for themselves which nonprofit organizations they want to support when they participate in CSF's workplace giving programs.
