Some things are central to who we are. We continue to offer choices in where and how you give, while raising important funds for our nonprofit partners.

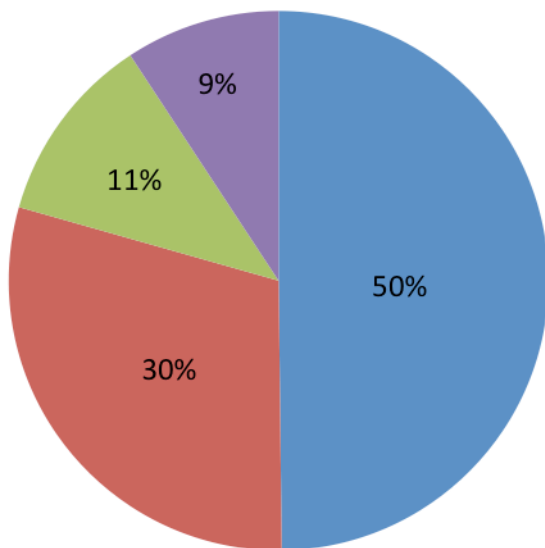
We also look at new ways to raise awareness of CSF and our members, to reach more people, and increase the impact of Community Services Fund and our nonprofit members.

With your support, we are improving the quality of life in Nebraska.

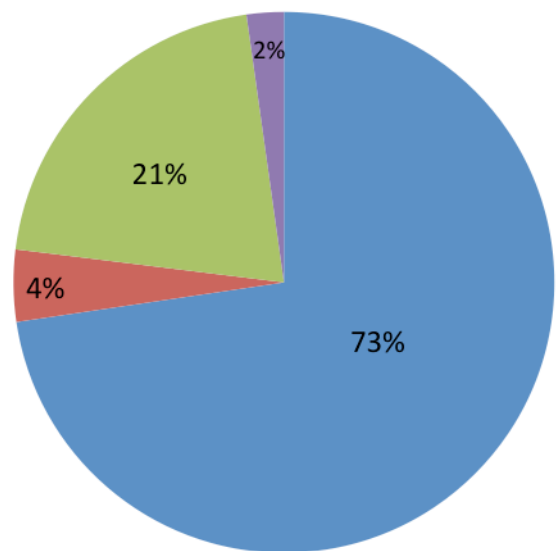

- Fundraising



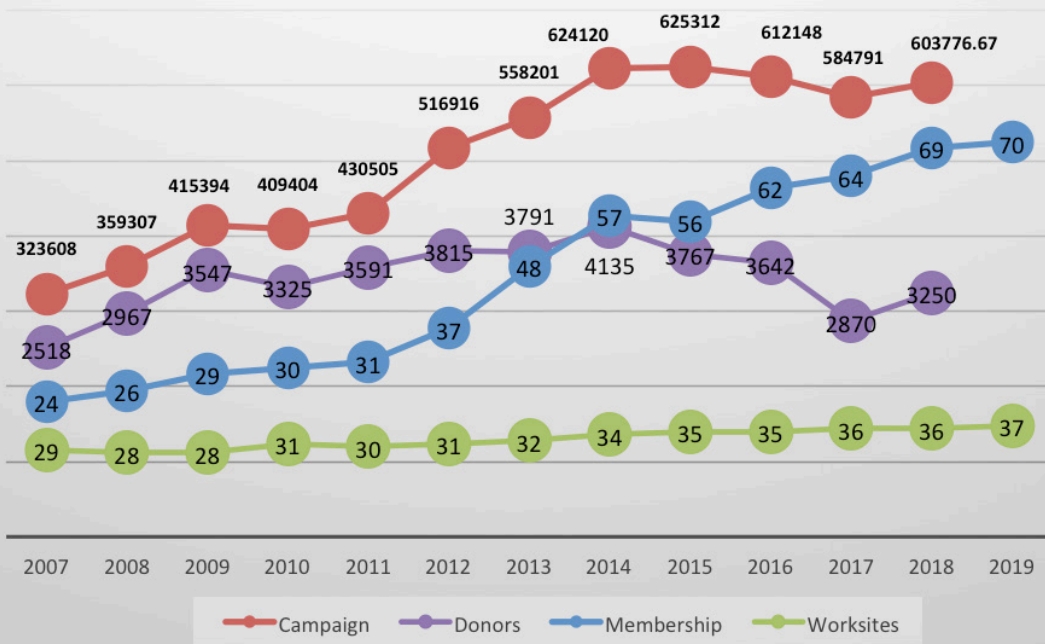
Through CSF, you can support arts and culture, youth and adults, animals and the environment, and so much more!
